

## PREPARATION FOR ENTRY

### VISA ENTRY

- Wait for the invitation to appear in your applicant's personal account.
- Once received, apply for a visa at the consulate. Then, upload your arrival date, a scan of your single-entry visa, and your travel tickets to your personal account.
- Purchase an additional medical insurance policy valid for one year. Follow the instructions in Memo 1, and enter the policy number, date of issue, and insurance company name in your personal account.
- If you require accommodation, select an option and follow the instructions in Memo 2.
- When crossing the border, fill out the migration card and keep the tear-off portion (second part).

### If you are being sent by the Ministry:

Wait for the invitation from the Ministry's address: [priem@ined.ru](mailto:priem@ined.ru)

- After receiving the invitation, apply for your visa at the consulate. Upload your arrival date, a scan of your single-entry visa, and travel tickets to your personal account.
- Purchase an additional medical insurance policy valid for one year. Follow Memo 1 and enter the policy number, date of issue, and insurance company name in your personal account.

### VISA-FREE ENTRY

- Wait for the invitation to appear in your applicant's personal account.
- Enter your arrival date and upload a scan of your tickets.
- Purchase an additional medical insurance policy valid for one year. Follow the instructions in Memo 1, and enter the policy number, date of issue, and insurance company name in your personal account.
- If you require accommodation, select an option and follow the instructions in Memo 2.
- Download the ruID app and complete your entry registration at least 72 hours before arrival, following the steps in Memo 3.
- When crossing the border, fill out the migration card and keep the tear-off portion.

## IMPORTANT

In addition to your required documents (foreign passport and educational certificates), please bring the following to Russia:

1. International Certificate of Preventive Vaccinations – the original certificate confirming your immunizations.
2. Photographs – size 3 × 4 cm (passport-style).

### ACTIONS ON THE FIRST DAY AFTER ARRIVAL

1. Upon arriving in St. Petersburg, you must check into the dormitory you selected in your personal account on the same day. If staying in a dormitory, the dormitory staff will handle your registration and migration procedures.
2. On the same day or the next business day (excluding weekends), you must report to:

Department of Support for Foreign Students Herzen State Pedagogical University of Russia Address: St. Petersburg, Kazanskaya Street, Building 6

Enter through the 1st-floor hall into the courtyard. Bring your passport.

3. If you are living at a private address, you must register at that address within 5 days of arrival together with the apartment owner. Then bring a copy of the registration document to the department.

### **If you were admitted by referral from the Ministry:**

Upon arrival in St. Petersburg, you must report on the same day to: Kazanskaya Street, Building 6,

Enter through the 1st-floor hall into the courtyard, and bring your passport.

This is required before moving into the inter-university student dormitory at:

Novoizmailovsky Prospect, 16 (Resettlement Building).

You must also provide the following:

- Passport (and a copy)
- One 3 × 4 cm photograph
- Results of a fluorographic examination
